Waar ben je mee bezig?

I'm working a lot in my studio. The studio is my haven. Because of the corona measures, social life is limited and I am more than fine with that. In the stu, I can work hard and concentrate fully. I'm finding my language, finding the best medium(s) to work with for the coming years. I work with tapestry and make paintings, large scale paintings, installations and scenographic works. This year I got a grant from the Stimuleringsfonds to develop my scenographic works. Everything I work on now, will be used for the scenography installation, which consists of constructive works (sculptures) and subwoofers (speakers). The Sandberg* was very important to me. The masters has really translated into a more coherent way of thinking. It taught me how to look at myself and translate what I saw creatively.

Waar heb je de lening voor gebruikt?

I used the loan for my graduation show with Radical Cut Up (Sandberg). The exhibition was at Looiersgracht 60 in Amsterdam. I bought materials for my tapestry and to produce a painting.

Wat heeft de lening voor je betekend?

It really helped me to move forward. It was a game changer. It got me over the hump when I was studying and gave me the peace of mind to properly concentrate. With the loan, I could realize the ideal presentation I had in mind.

exhibition in CBK Zuidoost. I'm also working on a publication. It is basically an amalgamation of writings and a formalized research compendium.

Wat zijn je toekomstplannen?

I want to continue what I'm doing and to go further into my process. And of course I'm working on the exhibition at CBK Zuidoost, where I will show paintings and tapestries. I have some other plans that I will not speak on here, but are definitely in motion and will be presented when these corona times have subsided.
